Competency-based Evaluation System (CES)

The aim...

The aim of the FEI Competency-based Evaluation System is to ensure that FEI Officials fulfil all the requirements of their job description and are up-to-date with the current FEI Rules and Regulations, regardless of their age.

The different competencies to be assessed at each level are:

- Knowledge of FEI Rules and Regulations (2020)
- Soft skills in order to interact effectively and harmoniously
- English language proficiency
- Physical fitness level required for the job

Phases of Implementation (CES)

Phase 1 (2020)

- evaluation of knowledge of FEI Rules and Regulations
- one assessment per discipline, except for Jumping which has three
- self-declaration “fit-to-officiate” according to the requirements of the role as an Official
- evaluation of English proficiency of Top Level Officials - a separate assessment with the opportunity to meet the required level within a year.

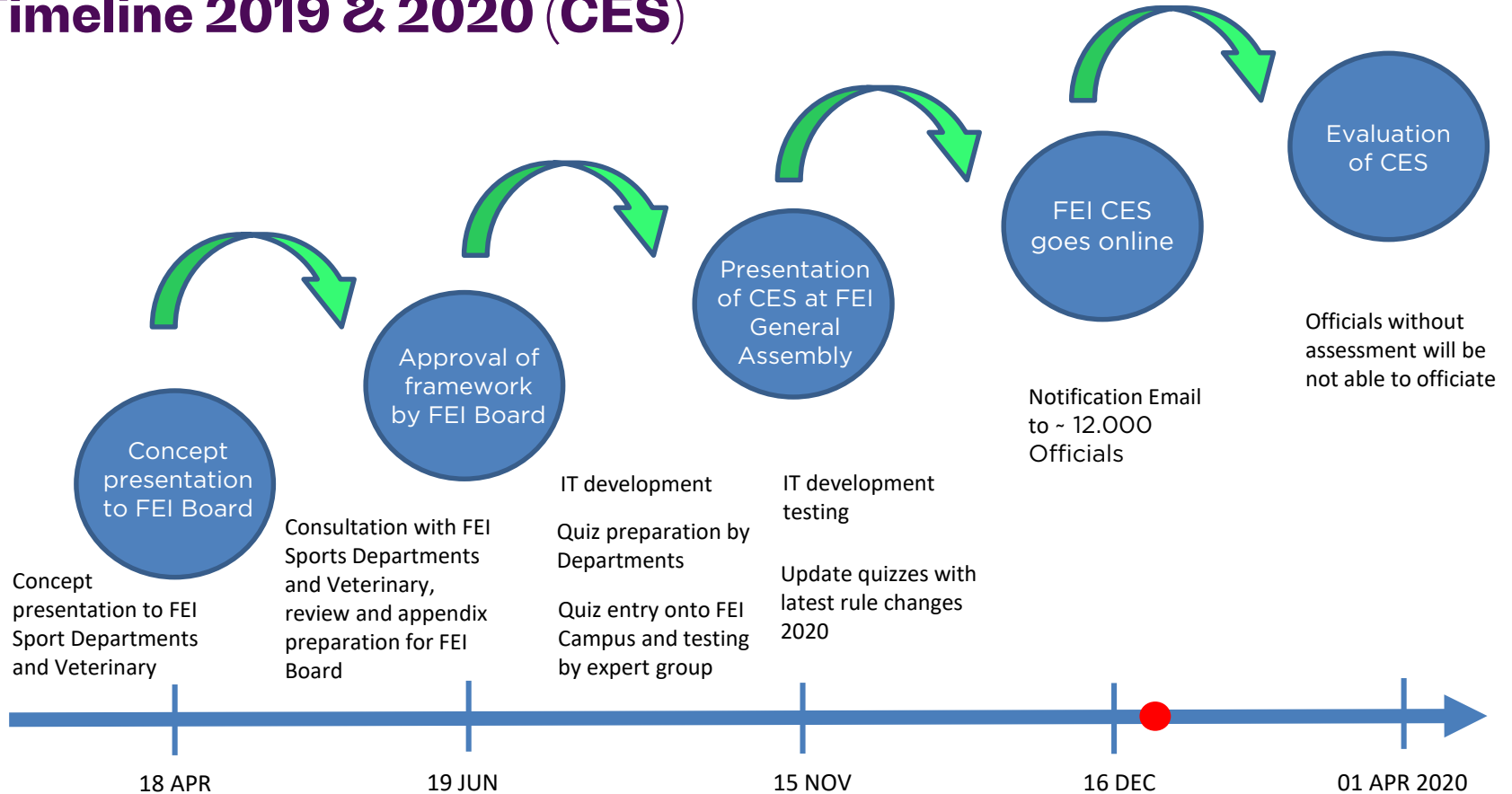
Phase 2

- assessments per category and/or level for each discipline

Phase 3

- soft skills evaluation for Top Level Officials

Timeline 2019 & 2020 (CES)



Online or in Person (CES)

Group A (online):

- Officials currently up-to-date with their refresher cycle
- Officials are able to officiate until 31 March 2020, after which they have to complete the CES online assessment prior to officiating.

Group B (in-person maintenance course with assessment)

- Officials without refresher since 31 December 2016
- Officials can officiate until 15 December 2020

Instructions

First step: please read and answer the "Fit-to-Officiate Declaration & Identity Authentication" after having read the instructions. This step is mandatory and can not be skipped.

Second step: Train with the "mock exam" in order to familiarise yourself with the assessment environment and question types. You can take it as many times as you wish and it is not timed. You can skip this step, but we highly recommend you to do it.

Third step: when ready please start the online assessment.

Rules for your online assessments in Group A:

- You have one (1) attempt which cannot be interrupted or restarted once started.
- You have one (1) hour to complete the assessment and you cannot pause it.
- You have to reach a completion rate of 80% to successfully pass the CES assessment.
- Should you not reach the required passing grade or interrupt your assessment for any reason, you will be given access to a second and last attempt after 15 days.
- In the eventuality of an unsuccessful second attempt, you will be required to join an in-person maintenance course before the 15 December 2020. Note that in this case, you will not be able to officiate until then.

Content of the assessment

- The assessment contains 50 questions covering General Regulations, Dressage Rules as well as Legal and Veterinary Regulations 2020.
- You might be presented with different types of questions:
 - multiple choice (one correct answer only);
 - multiple choice (more than one correct answer);
 - true/false;
 - select missing word.

Recommendations

To run the assessment in the best possible conditions, please make sure to:

- be in a quiet and comfortable environment;
- have a stable Internet connection;
- have a fully charged battery or connect your laptop/tablet to a power source.
- You **are** allowed to have your FEI Rule Book with you during this assessment.

Rules for your in-person assessments in Group B:

- You have one (1) attempt which cannot be interrupted or restarted once started.
- You have one (1) hour to complete the assessment and you cannot pause it.
- You have to reach a completion rate of 80% to successfully pass the CES assessment.
- Should you not reach the required passing grade or interrupt your assessment for any reason, you will have to pass an **oral assessment** during your in-person maintenance course with the Course Director who will assess whether you can maintain your level or if you **are** transferred down to the next lower level.
